



King Edward's Primary Sport Outreach Programme

King Edward's has provided primary school sport outreach and other primary school activities to our local community of primary schools for close to a decade.

These projects are well established in the community and well attended and valued by our primary schools.



Over the last three years (and longer) a number of Wolds SSP inter-school competition in sport has been provided at/by KEVIGS.

As a rule the following events/numbers attending each term have been consistent and ensures that we are providing for a wide range of ability and socio-economic backgrounds.

- Term 1 Modified Rounders Y2/3 x150+
- Term 2 Cross country KS2 x400+
- Term 4 Multi-sports Challenge Y4/5 x 300+
- Term 5 Primary Golf Y3/4 (London Rd) Y3/4 200+
- Term 6 Primary hockey KS2 (London Rd) 120+

The lack of suitable/quality facilities has limited KEVIGS' ability to be able to host more primary sports events. Examples of this include, basketball, sports hall athletics, badminton, table tennis and futsal.

We are also not able to cater for inclusive sports events such as boccia and new age curling. In previous years these events have been hosted by Cordeaux and Monks Dyke, now Louth Academy.

A positive has been that this year, for the first time KEVIGs are hosting the inter-school high 5 netball as we are the only school in Louth with 2 courts, (Louth Academy have always hosted this event but since the summer have lost 2 netball courts to be replaced by handball courts.

As a school, KEVIGS is missing out on many positive primary liaison opportunities within the local and wider community.
