Our Activity Hall was built in 1989 when the school had around 580 students on site: no sooner was it open then everyone quickly realised that it was not fit for purpose.

Today with 900+ students on site and projections that take us up to a 1000 students there is a very real need for King Edward's to get a new Sports Hall to replace our Activity Hall.

The picture above goes a little way to explaining why!

With 170 pupils in Year 7 it is – as shown above simply impossible for us to get all of the year group into this space. More than this we cannot get half the year group into this space so we have to get a third in and either rotate our curriculum at additional cost OR again at additional cost we utilise other local facilities like London Road Sports Ground and the Meridan Centre: this is replicated across all our year groups as even the smaller 130 or 150 groups cannot fit into this space without carouselling.

The new plans for a five court sports hall to replace our two court activity hall plus the inclusion of a fitness suite and an aerobics and dance studio would revolutionise sport and the opportunities for our students here at King Edward's.
