Consultation Evening 5pm – 7pm 6th December Newton Hall

King Edward's Activity Hall was built in 1989 when the school numbered just 580 pupils. The hall is a two badminton court space with changing rooms for a maximum of 25 girls and 25 boys: there are no other indoor sports spaces.

Today King Edward's has 900+ pupils on site and is projected to reach a 1000 pupils by 2023. Facilities that were deemed inadequate as soon as the school opened them in 1989 are utterly unfit for purpose today in 2018.

In addition to our own need many of you may be aware that the old sports halls and facilities at Monks Dyke and Cordeaux – now Louth Academy – have been closed to the public and wider community forcing many local sports teams and clubs to find alternative accommodation or in some instances to close their clubs.

King Edward's is planning to develop a new Sports Hall and Elite Performance Centre to support both the students of King Edward's and our core curriculum provision but also to support the wider sporting community in partnership with Magna Vitae.

We are planning to hold a consultation event on Thursday 6th December 5pm – 7pm in Newton Hall located off Crowtree Lane next to the school's activity hall. You will be able to view a rolling presentation of our plans and speak with members of the team including myself about our vision for the future.
