Thank you for considering King Edward VI Grammar School.

We are seeking an enthusiastic and talented Chemistry teacher who is experienced at teaching science up to and including GCSE and A Level and/or seeking their first move either to qualify or post ECT. The school is happy to receive applications from ECT's or other suitably qualified applicants.

The Science Department here at King Edward's is very successful and all students have the option to take Triple Science at GCSE thus enabling pupils to specialise. In addition, we have one or two sets each year who will take the Double Science route. The Science Department has a consistent track record of preparing students for University and the Science department as a whole has a strong regional reputation of excellence for preparing students for entry to Medicine and Veterinary courses. Finally, the ability to offer either a combination of Chemistry to KS4 or KS5 and a second science to KS3 or KS4 will be useful.
