A. Formal Curriculum Key Stage 4

Core Content & Skills	By the end of key stage FOUR we want all students of Spanish to know and do the following things: to have a cultural knowledge of customs and traditions in the Spanish-speaking world. To have a concrete understanding of Spanish grammar and to be able to apply this in new contexts and scenarios. To demonstrate a wide range of vocabulary across the GCSE topics to be able communicate effectively. To confidently demonstrate understanding and communicate across the different skills of reading, listening, speaking and writing.
Prior Knowledge & Skills	In KS4, students of Spanish will build on the following prior learning: topic vocabulary, understanding of all tenses and persons, range of links, reasons and opinions. Deepen knowledge of the Spanish-speaking world. Reading, listening, speaking, writing and translation skills.
Future knowledge	The Curriculum in KS4 Spanish will prepare students for the following future learning: more extensive use of all tenses in the indicative and develop use of the subjunctive mood. Use of more complex grammatical structures. Understanding and working with more advanced and complex texts and topics; use and develop skills such as research, analysis, evaluation, summarising, public speaking/presentations, listening, re-drafting, critical thinking, translation, problem solving and pattern recognition
